- Beni-Suef University implemented 5 years framework of programmes on sustainable development through consumption and production taking into account the development and abilities of the University faculties and Units of production (start ups)
- By 2030, we tried to achieve the sustainable management and efficient use of natural resources and recycle all type of wastes in the University to get benefit from new products with low cost.
- Wood recycling plants and machines to produce wood counter boards are existing in small factory at the faculty of industrial education (technological education) and also serve to decrease unemployment rates which is a significant issue here in EGYPT. Consequently, beating poverty by offering job opportunities. This small factory
- Food production centre manufactured many types of food including dairy products, meat, bakery, bread, ...and more than 3 centres were opened in the campuses and out of campus to serve people with reduced prices (prices are less than 50% those at the supermarkets). The food produced by this centre is distributed at the student hostel restaurants, at the conference and hotel centre, for all gatherings and meetings. This centre make use of the farm animals from the faculty of veterinary medicine and faculty of agriculture.
- In campus and out of campus convoys are always held to assure awareness everywhere for all people to possess relevant information and awareness for sustainable development, minimizing plastic use, minimizing water and energy usage, lifestyles with nature
- The food waste from all cafeterias and restaurants at the University are used to feed animals at the farm located at the faculty of veterinary medicine
- the environmental management of chemicals and hazardous wastes is always performed with partnership with societal partners from industrial companies specialized in this issue
- We are working hard to reduce waste generation via 4 main ways: prevention, (3R: reduction, recycling and reuse)
- Advanced innovative techniques were employed to monitor sustainable development impacts for sustainable tourism that creates jobs and promotes local culture and products (faculty of tourism and hotellerie, faculty of mass communication, faculty of applied arts....)
